Certificate of Compliance

All producers of electronic and electrical equipment manufactured and sold in Europe or imported or exported into or from a country member of the EU, must comply with the EU's Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive 2002/95/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 January 2003. The RoHS Directive mandates the maximum concentration level of six hazardous materials-Lead (Pb), Hexavalent chromium (Cr+6), Mercury (Hg), Cadmium (Cd), PolyBrominated Biphenyls (PBB) and PolyBrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE). Some exemptions are allowed, if present in Numonyx products, only lead content is concerned.

All the Numonyx marked and/or labeled with the second level interconnect (from e1 to e6) according to the Jedec Standard JESD97 conforms to the last revision of RoHS Directive noted.
